

NOTICE

The Academic Planning Committee has met and considered the issues of shorter time line/ access issues/ Online connectivity faced by the students and has resolved to revert back to the single project submission mode suspending the agreed upon new academic reforms. The following are the new guidelines and has been approved by the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor:

1. There will be single project submission for each paper for the Year II to Year V for 20 marks as CIA component.
2. The Projects to be evaluated for 20 marks merging the Viva component.
3. All CIA components for this semester will be projects and moot component has been suspended for this semester.
4. The class teachers will release the project topics before 16th of October, 2020.
5. The Phase I and Phase II submissions have been merged for a single time line of all submissions on or before 30th November 2020
6. The project to be of approximately 2500 words, Times New Roman font 12, One and half line spacing and standard margins.
7. The teachers will check for desired originality and if it is found not satisfactory will return it for resubmission within a week which will be final.
8. The Turnitin review will be implemented from the next semester and announcement of onboarding of students of the software and related access will be announced shortly.
9. As stated in the earlier notice of No.22767/HNLU/Reg./2020), dated 7/10/2020, the mode of end term exam of 2019-20 and the midterm/end term of the current semester to be done as per BCI guidelines.
