2.	Mode of Examination	Special Assignments of Critical Essays (SACE) + Viva Voce
3.	Mode of Evaluation	Two SACEs x 30 Marks per written submission = 60 Marks
4.	SACE Viva-Voce	15 Marks (Semester-II) 20 Marks (Semester-IV, VI & VIII)
5.	<b>Release of SACE topics</b>	<b>27<sup>th</sup> October 2021</b>
6.	Submission Timeline	To be submitted on or before <b>15<sup>th</sup> November, 2021</b>
7.	Word Limit	2500-3000 words (each SACE) including of footnotes/references/bibliography
8.	Line Spacing	1.5 Line Spacing
9.	Font Size	12 Points in Times New Roman
10.	Mode of Submission	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>SACEs to be submitted in a <b>single pdf with full turnitin report</b> to the <b>given link</b> provided in SACE question paper.</li><li>For facilitating similarity checking, students will be provided access to the Turnitin Class created by the respective faculty</li><li>Submissions will not be accepted if the students are resorting to unfair/unethical practices.</li><li>Students shall mandatorily <b>keep full Turnitin Report of their assignments</b> for future course of action.</li></ul>
11.	Citations/Footnotes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Harvard Bluebook 20<sup>th</sup> Edition</li></ul>
12.	Similarity Check of SACEs	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>By Turnitin (Permissible Turnitin Similarity Index is up to 30%)</li><li>For more details on similarity checks and penalty, see annexure (HNLU-Anti-Plagiarism and integrity Policy as notified on 24/12/2020)</li></ul>
13.	Penalty on Late Submissions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>One day delay: one-mark deduction</li><li>Two days delay: Two-marks deduction</li><li>Three days delay: Three-marks deduction</li><li>Four days delay: Four-marks deduction</li><li>Five days delay: Five-marks deduction</li><li>Post 5 days, the submissions will not be taken for evaluation and such students have to repeat the same in the next schedule. The methodology and timeline will be announced in due course.</li></ul>
