Postgraduate level questions will be asked for the interdisciplinary paper of the HNLU Ph.D entrance examination. Descriptive answer type questions will be asked from the following two parts

Part A: Indian legal system, fundamentals of Indian Constitution, Structure of the Indian judicial system, Role of judiciary in democratic societies, judicial review, judicial activism in India and public interest litigation, civil court process, criminal court process.

Part B: One question will be asked from the PG degree specialization of the candidate. The focus of the question will be on the interdisciplinary aspects of that subject with the discipline of law.

- Each question will have a weightage of 25 Marks, and the total mark will be 50 (2 x 25 =50)
