The Legal Social Services Committee believes that ‘A small step towards something big is the biggest step towards it’. Below are the glimpses of the works along with the position hold by the Participants: -

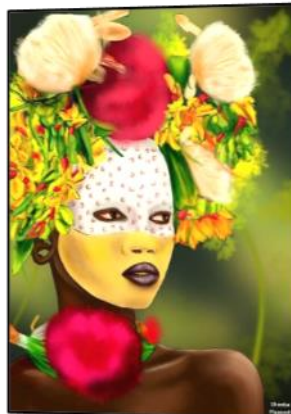
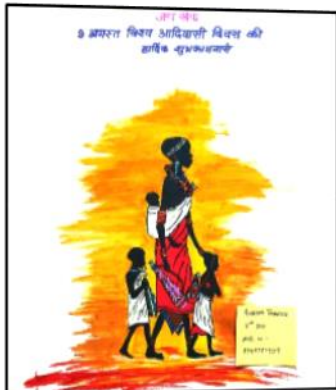
