MINUTESOF THE LIMITED AGENDA EXECUTIVE COUNCIL MEETING (Online) HELD ON 13.07.2021 AT 6.00 P.M.

An Online meeting of the Executive Council of Hidayatullah National Law University took place on 13.07.2021 at 6:00 p.m., wherein the following Hon'ble Members were present:

Prof.V.C.Vivekanandan, Vice Chancellor and Chair of the Executive Council welcomed the members and requested Hon'ble Shri Justice M. R. Shah, Judge, Supreme Court of India to Chair the meeting.

Thereafter, with due permission of the Chair, the agenda items were taken up and decided as under:

1. Perusal and confirmation of the recommendations of the Selection Committee of faculty positions for the interviews held on 8-10/16-17 and 27th of June 2021 as part of Phase-II.

Notes:

The appointment notification no. 1 of 2021 was published on 24th February 2021 by the University for the Post of Registrar, Professor, Associate Professor and Assistant Professor. The Executive Council has already approved the recommendations of selection committee for the post of Registrar, Professor and Associate Professor as part of Phase-I selection process in the special meeting held on 6th June 2021 and appointment orders issued. The faculty are in the process of joining the University

The Vice Chancellor placed before the members the following:

A. In phase-II the interviews for the post of Assistant Professors was conducted on the dates of 8th to 10th& 16th, 17th& 27th of June of 2021. The recommendations of the Selection Committee are placed for perusal and approval(Annexure-I to be placed during the meeting with the permission of the Chair)

- B. To increase the duration of Ad hoc Professors from the maximum of current three years to five years in tune with the five-year course from the current maximum of three years subject to annual renewal based on performance appraisal and availability of the posts viz a viz regular appointment.
- C. To explore the feasibility of further Ad Hoc appointments of regular posts if not filled in spite of three consecutive advertisement

Decision:

After the deliberation initiated by the Chair Hon'ble Mr. Justice M.R. Shah, Judge Supreme Court of India, the following decisions were taken:

- A. The members present unanimously endorsed the decision to give the appointment orders to the selected candidates by the Selection Committee of the University and waitlisted candidates if any offer is declined by the selected candidates for an early joining date with the proposed academic year of 201-22 scheduled from 16th August 2021. (Annexure-I: List of selected and waitlisted candidates by the Selection Committee).
- B. Endorsed the decision that the maximum period of Ad hoc employment can be extended to a maximum of five years but subject to annual review of performance appraisal and availability of positions viz a viz regular positions.

- C. The Chair and members decided to defer the additional request of Ad hoc positions against vacant positions for a thorough study of the proposal with consultation of State Government in the forthcoming EC meeting.
- 2. Proposal to start recovery process of wrongful payment to the Seven (7) staff members given in the CAG report along with schedule and modalities.

Notes:

The Executive Council in its meeting dated 20.12.2020 decided that the university shall submit a schedule of recovery on the wrongful payment detailed by the CAG to Seven (7) in its report submitted in 2018 and also directed by the EC to recover the same in its meeting held on 7th December 2019 after auditing internally. The same was audited by the University and has prepared the total amount due and a recovery process starting from July 2021

The report and schedule are place for the approval of the Hon'ble members of the Executive Council.(Annexure II)

Decision:

A. The members directed the University to implement the corrected salary as per CAG and vetted by the Finance officer of the University starting from the July 2021 salary without delay.

ANNEXURE 1 - A

Regulation for Adhoc teaching positions

- The Ad hoc posts of faculty is for a period of one year and renewable annually for a
 maximum of five years based on performance appraisal and also based on the availability
 of such posts as decided by the University authorities.
- 2. The position is offered at Level 10 of the CPC Pay Matrix with applicable University allowances. The selected faculty are entitled for annual increments after successful appraisal of every year and not entitled for any other increments unless expressly sanctioned by the Executive Council.
- 3. That the said faculty member shall be liable to be transferred or assigned other academic duties under the University, if necessary;
- 4. That the said faculty member will be bound by the provisions of the Act, the Regulations and Rules in force from time to time in the University and in particular by those relating to the service conditions as indicated in the order of appointment;
- 5. That the said faculty member shall devote his/her whole time to the service of the University, and shall not without the permission of the University, engage, directly or indirectly, in any trade or business whatsoever, or in any private tuition or other work to which any emolument or honorarium is attached; but this prohibition shall not apply to work undertaken with prior permission of the Vice-Chancellor, in connection with the examinations of other institutes, work of public service commissions, short assignments as examiners, judges of moots/literary/sports/cultural/ media activities/academic publishing/research/selection committees/ Board of Studies/ advisory roles/visiting positions and related activities.
- 6. The faculties are entitled for campus residential quarters based on the housing policy of the University.
