## Notification Inviting CVs of Students for Consideration of award of Chancellor's Gold Medal, Dinesh Prasad Shrivastava Memorial Gold Medal (Best Graduating Student) and Syed Afzal Rizvi Gold Medal

It is hereby informed that the University has initiated the process of determining the award of Gold Medals for the graduated students of B.A.LL.B. (Hons.) Batch-XVIII. The criteria to award the above Metals are as follows:

### 1. The Criteria for awarding the Chancellor's Gold Medal (For overall best performance) & Dinesh Prasad Shrivastava Memorial Gold Medal (Best Graduating Student) are as follows:

- Academic Performance (CGPA);
- Participation and Performance in Moot Court Competitions (National/International);
- Publication of Research Papers in National/International Journals of refereed/peer-review nature and Articles in Newsletters/Magazines/Blogs/News Papers;
- Presentation/Participation in Seminar/Workshop/Conference (National/International); and
- Extra-Curricular Activities covering participation in various sports, cultural, literary, and debating events/competitions including parliamentary debates, MUN etc. and holding of leadership positions in SBA and other Committees/Bodies within and outside the University.

Those students having 5 (five) or more than 5 (five) CGPA are required to submit their CVs along with digital copies of proofs in support of their claims.

### 2. The Criteria for awarding Syed Afzal Ahmed Rizvi Gold Medal are as follows:

- The first top 10 (ten) students cumulatively securing the highest marks in the papers of Cr. P. C., I. P. C. and Law of Evidence; and
- Participation and performance in Moot Court Competitions at the National and International level.


The top 10 (ten) students listed in Annexure – II may submit their Moot participation/performance details with digital copies of proofs in support of their claims. Out of the ten students, the best student will be awarded the Gold Medal.

### Essential qualifying Criteria for award of Gold Medal are as follows:

- To be considered for Gold Medal in any course, group of courses taken together or for overall/all-round best performance, the student must have completed all the courses in one chance, i.e., without any repeat or improvement in any of the courses.
- The student must not have against him/her any proven charge of misconduct on grounds of violation of rules or breach of code of conduct.
- The student must have secured a minimum of 5 GPs/GPA in relevant course/courses or must have secured 5 CGPA in case of overall/all-round best performance.

In order to be considered for the above three gold medals, the students are required to submit their latest CVs with relevant supporting documents failing which their claim shall not be considered. The latest CVs and relevant supporting documents are to be sent through email to [exam@hnlul.ac.in](mailto:exam@hnlul.ac.in) latest by 18<sup>th</sup> November 2023 by 11:59 p.m.

**Note:** Only those academic and other achievements / accomplishments obtained during 1st July 2018 to 30th June 2023 will be considered for the award of gold medals.
