1.	<p data-bbox="386 453 1187 485"><u>Detention Policy and Exemption Sought from Students.</u></p> <p data-bbox="386 516 477 548"><u>Notes:</u></p> <p data-bbox="386 552 1432 835">The Academic Council in its meeting held on July 8, 2021, passed the detention policy to be applied for the B.A.LL.B. (Hons) program for the batch admitted from 2021. Consequently, the same was also communicated to the students through the website. In the batch of 2021, a total of 24 students have accumulated arrears of one or more papers and face detention as per the policy. Those students have fervently appealed that they were unaware and not adequately briefed of the policy and hence exempt them from the same. The students have also appealed to the Hon'ble Chancellor on this subject which has been forwarded to us for appropriate resolution.</p> <p data-bbox="386 873 1432 961">The Deans of the University met and decided that this to be referred to the Academic Council, recommending a one-time exemption of one year as follows: -</p> <p data-bbox="386 1016 1432 1381">“Based on the oversight of the detention policy notification by the affected students, the University can give a one-time exemption of the detention policy. However, it is ascertained that the detention/promotion policy is effective from the 2021-2022 batch and hence, they need to clear all the backlog papers of the years pertaining to 2021-2022 / 2022-2023 before being promoted to the Seventh (VII) (i.e. fourth year- 2024-2025). Similarly, they need to clear all the papers of 2023-2024 (i.e. third year) in order to get promoted to the ninth semester (i.e. fifth year) in 2025-2026.”</p> <p data-bbox="386 1451 521 1482"><u>Decision:</u></p> <p data-bbox="386 1499 1432 1625">The members of the Academic Council deliberated the issue and unanimously approved the proposal of the Collegium of Deans recommending the implementation of the one-time exemption.</p>
