1.	<p>To deliberate and decide on the appeal of the parents of 14 detained students of Batch 2022-23 under the Promotion/Detention Policy.</p> <p>Notes:</p> <p>1. The 14 students of the 2022-23 batch were detained due to backlog papers in their first and second Semesters. The Promotion/Detention Policy was intimated during the induction programme held on July 26, 2022. The notice dated 17.06.2022 was uploaded on the website on 12.01.2023. The students were also reminded by email/personal counseling in 2023 of the implications of not clearing the backlog of first and second semesters.</p>

The parents of the detained students of 2022-23 batch had appealed to the Academic Council to consider them for promotion to third year with a chance to clear their backlog papers as a one-time condonation.</p> <p data-bbox="320 487 480 519"><u>Decision:</u></p> <p data-bbox="320 561 1465 779">The members present deliberated and decided to condone the detention of the 14 students of 2022-23 batch from second year to third year based on the mercy plea of one-time condonation and this decision strictly will not be a precedent for future batches. The said students need to clear the backlog of first to six semesters of 2022 to 2025 before being promoted to the ninth semester.</p> <p data-bbox="320 821 1465 967">The members also appreciated the measures announced by the University for remedial classes/counseling to the students and to procure a written affidavit from the parents on the final chance of condonation relating to the Promotion/Detention Policy.</p>
