1.	<p><b>Regarding representation of the detained students of Batch 2021 and Batch 2022.</b></p> <p><b>Notes:</b> The University has received representation from the detained students and their parents of Batch 2021 and 2022 to allow them to be promoted to Seventh Semester and to write the backlog papers. The representation has also been made to the Hon'ble Chancellor on this matter and the Office of the Chancellor has forwarded the representation of the students to the University.</p>

	<p>Accordingly, it is placed before the Academic Council for deliberation and direction to the University on this matter.</p> <p><b><u>Decision:</u></b></p> <p>Representations made by the detained students and the parents of the detained students of batch of 2021 were considered and deliberated in detail. In view of the fact that the students of the batch 2021 could not be informed about the detention policy at the time of their admission at HNLU Raipur and further taking note of the fact that the detention policy was notified subsequently on 17 June 2022, it is unanimously resolved to promote them to the seventh semester with the condition that they need to clear all the backlog papers of first six semesters before promoting them to the ninth semester. The University is required to give appropriate repeat chances to such detained students to clear their backlog papers of different semesters in Academic Year 2024-25. No further relaxation will be given to them. It is further made clear that this relaxation is strictly only for the batch of 2021-22, and it will not be applicable to subsequent batches because at the time of their admission the detention policy had been duly notified, and they were duly informed about the said detention policy at the time of their respective admission in HNLU Raipur.</p>
