FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQs)

1. What is the submission deadline and guidelines for memorials, including the exact date and time?

Answer. The submission deadline for soft copy of memorials is 15th March 2025, 5:00 PM (IST). Teams must submit the soft copy of the memorials through the link which will be provided to registered teams. Additionally, hard copies of the memorials must be brought along when teams arrive on campus as per the rule mentioned in the brochure. **Rule 9.1** shall apply for submission of soft copies. There are no memorial knockout rounds but the memorials will be evaluated for purposes as mentioned in the brochure.

2. Do all team members, including researchers and speakers, need to be physically present at the campus during the competition?

Answer. Yes, the event is purely physical in nature. All team members are required to be physically present on campus during the competition. In exceptional cases, if a team cannot be accompanied by a Researcher, a Speaker may take the Researcher's Test in their place. This allowance will be subject to the discretion of the Organising Committee.

3. What is the nature/type (objective or subjective) and scope of questions in the Researcher's Test?

Answer. The Researcher's Test will be in the form of Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs) and the questions will be from the moot proposition and relevant subject area. There will be a total of 50 (Fifty) questions carrying 2 marks each and there will be a negative marking of 0.5 marks for every incorrect answer.

4. When and where will the Researcher's Test be conducted, and what is the specific date and time?

Answer. The Researcher's Test will be conducted on campus on 21st March 2025, immediately after the Inaugural Ceremony.

5. Is accommodation provided for team coaches during the competition, and what are the associated guidelines and costs?

Answer. Upon request, coaches may be provided accommodation on the HNLU campus upon payment of the guest house charges. However, meals would be complimentary.

6. Rule 9 refers to Rule 8(a), 8(b), 8(c), but Rule 8 includes only 8.1, 8.2, etc. How should the penalty deductions be interpreted?

Answer. This is a typographical error. Participants are requested to interpret the references in Rule 9 as follows:

- (A) 'Rule 8(a)' should be read as Rule '8.1'.
- (B) 'Rule 8(b)' should be read as Rule '8.2'.
- (C) 'Rule 8(c)' should be read as 'Rule 8.3'.



7. Rule 12.4 of the brochure mentions a cash prize of INR 50,000 (Rs. Seventy five thousand only) for the Best Researcher Award. What is the correct prize amount?

Answer. This is a typographical error. It should be read as:

“The researcher with the highest score in the Researcher Test will get the ‘Best Researcher’ prize along with a cash prize of INR 50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand Only).”

8. The term "informant/ appellant" and "respondent/opposite party" in rule 8.7 to be read as "petitioner" and "respondent"

9. Awards and Trophies :

Winner of the 2nd HIMCC - INR 2,00,000/- (Rupees Two Lakh Rupees Only)

Runner Up - INR 1,50,000/- (Rupees One Lakh Fifty Thousand Only)

Best Memorial - INR 75,000/- (Rupees Seventy Five Thousand Only)

Best speaker - INR 75,000/- (Rupees Seventy Five Thousand Only)

Best Researcher - INR 50000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand Only)
