HOSTEL VACATION GUIDELINES

1. Vacation after every Semester End-Term Examinations

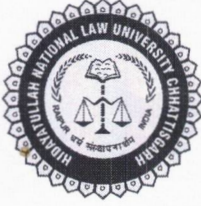
- I. All students shall vacate their allotted hostel rooms within 24 hours of completing their last end-term examination each semester, unless permitted to stay under valid exemptions with prior approval from the Office of the Registrar.
- II. Students are required to make advance travel arrangements. Any request for extension beyond the stipulated 24-hour period must be submitted at least 15 days before the commencement of vacation, with valid justification and written approval from the office of the Registrar.
- III. Students vacating for winter/summer breaks must ensure that their rooms are securely locked and that no valuables are left behind. The University shall not be responsible for any loss or damage.
- IV. Students currently on the rolls who have backlog/repeat examinations must mandatorily apply in advance for hostel accommodation, in accordance with the timelines notified by the HMRC from time to time.
- V. Ex-students appearing for repeat examinations shall be permitted hostel accommodation only upon prior approval from the office of the Registrar and subject to submission of the prescribed accommodation form issued by the HMRC. Such stay shall be governed strictly by HMRC rules.

2. Mandates for Students Appearing for Repeat-I / Repeat-II Examinations

- I. Students on the rolls intending to stay in the hostel during Repeat-I and/or Repeat-II examinations must inform the HMRC strictly as per the notified instructions. Non-compliance may result in immediate eviction.
- II. During such permitted stay, all hostel and campus rules must be strictly adhered to. Any violation shall result in expulsion from the hostel and disciplinary proceedings. Occupying or using rooms allotted to other students in their absence is strictly prohibited.

3. Mandates for Ex-Students and Students Under Hostel Suspension

- I. Ex-students or students under hostel suspension must obtain prior written permission from the Registrar for any hostel stay during repeat examinations. Entry into the campus without such permission is strictly prohibited.
- II. Upon receiving approval, the student must inform the HMRC and Accounts Section well in advance via email, enclosing:
 - (a) Copy of the permission of the Registrar.
 - (b) Proof of payment of applicable charges.
 - (c) Proposed schedule of stay aligned with examination dates.

4. General Regulations

- I. All students residing on campus during repeat examinations shall be governed by the Rules of Hall of Residence (HoR) and HNLU disciplinary rules.
- II. Any breach of HoR rules shall invite disciplinary action by the Proctorial Board.
- III. In-timing regulations:
 - Campus: 9:00 p.m.
 - Hostel: 10:00 p.m.
- IV. Access to University facilities (gym, medical services, library, and other amenities) shall be regulated in accordance with vacation schedules and timings.
- V. The Learning Resource Centre (LRC) shall function from 10:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. on working days and shall remain closed on weekends and notified holidays.
- VI. Any violation of disciplinary rules will result in immediate suspension from the hostel and other penalties, including the cancellation of repeat exams.
